Wooden barrel

Wooden barrels are one of the accessories more used when finalizing a diorama, as they bring greater realism to the scene. This guide shows how to paint a wooden barrel with precision, in a very realistic way and with great definition around the wooden texture.

- 1 A layer of Surface Primer Black 70.602 is airbrushed and then two thin layers of Grey 74.601.



- 2 To create different wood effects the barrel is painted with several colors: Japan Uniform WWII 70.923, Flat Earth 70.983 and Orange Brown 70.981.



- 3 Washes are applied with Sepia 72.091 and a little bit of Flat Earth 70.983 to define further the woods.



- 4 With Woodgrain 70.828 glazes are applied for greater detail on the woods.



- 5 Very subtle glazes are applied to the grain of the wood with Japan Uniform WWII 70.923 and Dark Sand 70.847.



- 6 Lastly, Intermediate Green 70.891 is applied to some grooves on the barrel to simulate moss.



- 7 Final result.
