## Orange armor

This guide shows how to paint orange armor using a step-by-step technique to achieve great results quickly and easily.

- 1 First, the head is separated from the body enabling you to paint the figure more comfortably. A primer is applied, using Hobby Paint Spray Sun Yellow 28.018.



- 2 Across the lower areas, shadows are added with Game Air Hot Orange 72.709.



- 3 This armor will be highlighted using the airbrush in 2 steps. First, Game Air Dead White 72.701 is applied mixed with a little Game Air Moon Yellow 72.705.



- 4 The highlighting is completed using very dilute Game Air Moon Yellow 72.705. It is airbrushed over the white areas from the previous step, resulting in an intense yellow.



- 5 Game Wash Umber Wash 73.203 is applied in all the nooks and crannies of the armor, applying it carefully with the brush. It can be mixed with a little Model Color German Cam. Black Brown 70.822 to obtain a more opaque wash.



- 6 To finish, the armor is edge highlighted using Model Color Ice Yellow 70.858. A tiny bit of Model Color White 70.951 can be added to the mix to increase the intensity in some areas.
